STATE POLICY IN THE ARCTIC

Ministry for the Development of the Russian Far East started the selection of investment projects in the Arctic

The Ministry for the Development of the Russian Far East began admitting applications from investors who plan to implement investments projects in the Arctic and who will receive help from the state to build the infrastructure. According to the ministry's statement, the selection process will last until 1 June.



Those who invest no less than 300 million roubles in Arctic projects will be able to apply for a nonrepayable subsidy worth up to 20% of the amount of their investments. The selection procedure was approved by the Government of the Russian Federation in March. tass.ru/ekonomika/8251073

State Duma enacted a law on expanding the resource base for LNG export

This will allow to involve four deposits with total reserves of over 1.5 trillion cubic metres of gas into LNG production and increase the loading of the Northeast Passage where LNG can account for at least 70 million tonnes of loading by 2030. These are Novatek's Verkhnetiuteyskoye, Zapadno-Seyakhinskoye, Shtormovoye and Soletsko-Khanaveyskoye fields.

Today, Gazprom, Gazprom Export, Rosneft and Novatek's subsidiaries Yamal LNG, Arctic LNG-1, Arctic LNG-2 and Arctic LNG-3 have the rights to export LNG. Novatek also plans to build another export centre (Obsk LNG) based on Verkhnetiuteyskoye and Zapadno-Seyakhinskoye

Expected amount of investment for projects in the Arctic region exceeds 200 billion roubles

"The expected amount of investment in promising investment projects in the Arctic regions of the Republic of Sakha (Yakutia) that can be eligible for this infrastructure support exceeds 200 billion roubles, over 30% of which is private investment. More than 2,000 new jobs are to be created," said the region's press office.

The largest projects to be implemented on the territory of Yakutia's Arctic zone are deposit development projects: rare earth metals at Tomtorskoye deposit, stream tin at Tirekhtyakh deposit, silver at Prognoz deposit (Polymetal company), ore gold at Kyuchus deposit, and diamonds at Molodiskaya and Ebelyakhskaya deposits (Almazy Anabara company). tass.ru/ekonomika/8227087

Five companies to become residents of the Capital of the Arctic ASEZ in Murmansk

Five companies plan to become residents of the Capital of the Arctic ASEZ in Murmansk by investing almost 140 billion roubles. If the project is approved, it will become the first ASEZ under the Ministry outside the Far Eastern region.

It was reported earlier that the Government of the Russian Federation granted the authority to manage ASEZs in the Russian Arctic to the Far East Development Corporation. tass.ru/ekonomika/8300139

LASH carrier Sevmorput delivered over 20,000 freight units to Arctic LNG-2

The nuclear-powered container ship Sevmorput delivered materials and equipment for Arctic LNG-2 project to the Gyda Peninsula, according to the Atomflot press service.

In total, over 20,000 freight units of breakbulk cargo was delivered to Utrenneye deposit, including reinforced concrete structures, tubulars, metal structures, construction machines and equipment.



Sevmorput left the port of Arkhangelsk on 17 March and arrived in the Gulf of Ob on 22 March. The unloading on the coast ice was completed on 4 April. The next day the carrier departed to Murmansk.

Russian paratroopers for the first time landed from an altitude of 10,000 meters in the Arctic

A group of Russian paratroopers become the first in the world to jump from 10,000 metres in Arctic latitudes.

They jumped from II-76 aircraft over the archipelago of Franz Josef Land. Paratroopers used cutting-edge equipment, including new-generation special parachute systems, oxygen masks and navigation equipment developed for extreme Arctic conditions.

Young Reindeer Herder programme to be launched this year in Yakutia

Implementation of Young Reindeer Herder and Arctic Teacher programmes for supporting residents of Yakutia's Arctic regions is to begin this year. Over the period of less than 10 years the number of people involved in reindeer herding almost halved.

The Young Reindeer Herder programme will be funded from the regional budget. Residents under 35 will be able to receive up to 1 million roubles to improve their living conditions. The programme requires that a reindeer herder must stay in the region and have working experience. The money can be spent on housing construction or buying housing on the secondary market.

Russian Arctic National Park switched to solar panels

The Russian Arctic National Park switched to alternative energy due to the beginning of the polar day.



"From May to October the Omega polar station will be powered by solar panels. The main advantage of green energy use is producing no harmful emissions into the atmosphere. During summer months, the park saves up to 2.5–3 tonnes of fuel by using only solar panels," said the head of Russian Arctic A. Kirillov.

In the future the park plans to switch the Omega all-year station entirely to this green energy, which means using no diesel even during the dark winter months.

Yakutia counted its polar bears

On the coast of the East Siberian Sea, the study of the polar bear and its life during the spring was finished.

Over the period of two weeks, experts covered more than a thousand kilometres on snowmobiles and an all-terrain vehicle along the Kolyma River and on the ice of the Kolyma Gulf. During the expedition they registered traces, met polar bears, found their family lairs. Also they collected biomaterials for genetic tests.

"This year we registered five family lairs. Judging by traces and encounters, we can say that during the spring there were at least 20 polar bears on the islands, including cubs," tells expedition leader V. Nikiforov.
