INTERNATIONAL ARCTIC FORUM MOVES TO ST. PETERSBURG

St. Petersburg to host International Arctic Forum 2019

The Organizing Committee of the 5th 'Arctic: Territory of Dialogue' International Arctic Forum held a meeting in Moscow on 17 January chaired by Russian Deputy Prime Minister and Presidential Plenipotentiary Envoy to the Far Eastern Federal District Yury Trutnev.

The Committee decided to relocate the Forum, which is to be held on 9–10 April 2019, from Arkhangelsk to the ExpoForum Exhibition and Convention Centre in St. Petersburg. The decision is based on the need to accommodate a larger number of guests and participants at the Forum than in 2017 as well as the inability of Arkhangelsk's hotel infrastructure to handle the growing demand. https://www.ntv.ru/novosti/2139721/

Chukotka to present projects on gold mining and environment at International Arctic Forum

The authorities of Chukotka are planning to present projects on gold mining, environment, and preservations of indigenous peoples at the 'Arctic: Territory of Dialogue' International Arctic Forum, according to the regional government.

"A new forum venue means more responsibility for us. We have things worth seeing. Those are projects on subsoil usage, infrastructure, development of the Baimka ore zone, and projects on preserving traditional ways of life of indigenous small-numbered peoples and environmental projects," says Governor of Chukotka Roman Kopin according to the press release.

"Originally, 1,510 participants were expected based on the data as of spring 2018. Today, it is more than 4 thousand people and the registration is still open. This is why the decision was made to relocate the Forum to St. Petersburg," said Lev Levit, Representative of the Governor of the Arkhangelsk Region for Arctic Development at a press conference.

Other events of the Arctic agenda are suggested to be held in Arkhangelsk: the forum on natural resources and environment of the Arctic, SPIEF off-site sessions 'Russia's Regions: New Areas of Growth', meetings of the Association of Polar Explorers, etc., said Lev Levit at a press conference. The Representative of the Governor emphasized that federal funds allocated to the Forum for development of Arkhangelsk infrastructure will still be provided. Renovation of Lomonosov Northern (Arctic) Federal University premises and reconstruction of the runway at Arkhangelsk airport will be monitored till the work is completed.

GOVERNMENTAL POLICY IN THE ARCTIC REGION

Yury Trutnev to suggest candidates for Deputy Minister for the Development of the Russian Far East on Arctic Affairs to Dmitry Medvedev

Yury Trutnev, Deputy Prime Minister of the Russian Federation and Presidential Plenipotentiary Envoy to the Far Eastern Federal District of the Russian Federation, will nominate candidates for the position of Deputy Minister for the development of the Russian Far East on Arctic Affairs anytime soon.

"I have suggestions and I'm going to submit them to Dmitry Medvedev upon return from the business trip," said Yury Trutnev.

Earlier, Dmitry Medvedev proposed to expand the responsibilities of the Ministry for the Development of the Russian Far East by adding Arctic issues. This governmental body is already engaged in fulfilling similar tasks. Dmitry Medvedev noted that for Russia the Arctic is a crucial region that has a powerful resource potential and where new ports are being built and new energy capacities are being created. However, he says that there is no single entity in the Government to coordinate this work on a regular basis.

Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment develops the Regulation on Russian Arctic National Park

The document sets out activities that are prohibited in the park given the regimen of special protection. The relevant draft order is published on the portal for regulations drafts.

The national park is located in the Arkhangelsk Region in Primorsky District and Novaya Zemlya Urban Area. Arctic to become the region of stability and collaboration

The 'Arctic Frontiers' 13th international conference took place in Norwegian Tromsø and was visited by delegations from 35 countries. It was mentioned at the Forum that the interest in the Arctic is, first of all, based on global climate change that manifests as accelerated ice cover thaw. The major reason, however is the data on untold riches of the Arctic and new emerging technologies for deep-sea drilling that allow mining natural resources from the seabed under severe northern conditions. As for Russia, almost 100% of diamonds, antimony, apatite, 95% of platinoids, about 95% of nickel, cobalt, chrome, and manganese, 60% of copper, 40% of gold are produced in the Arctic Circle.

Russian Foreign Ministry's Ambassador-at-Large Nikolay Korchunov who is responsible for the international cooperation in the Arctic noted that another reason why the conference in Norway was interesting for Russia was the upcoming international forum 'Arctic: Territory of Dialogue' to be held in St. Petersburg in April. "We are hoping that this constructive exchange of views that we saw in Tromsø, will be logically continued in the Northern Capital of Russia." summarized Mr. Korchunov.

Rosscongress provides Lomonosov Northern (Arctic) Federal University with 2.5 million roubles for unmanned aerial vehicles in arctic conditions modelling school

The Roscongress Foundation will provide grants to Russian social projects with 2.5 million roubles set aside for their support as part of a charity programme. The criteria for selecting grant applicants were announced in Sochi last year during the work of the Social Impact Lounge at the Russian Investment Forum. Projects were selected over the course of the year in five categories: social services, culture, medicine, youth initiatives, and social entrepreneurship.

The grant for the 'Youth Initiatives' nomination was awarded to the Lomonosov Northern (Arctic) Federal University for the creation of a 'From Youth Models to Arctic Drones' school for modelling unmanned aerial vehicles in arctic conditions.
